## **Sing with the Choir! – practise at home audio and video.**

Regina Caeli Jubila. (*Michael Praetorius (1571-1621), adapted words.*)

This is a light, joyful piece, celebrating the Assumption of Mary. It has three voices SAB (soprano, alto, bass). The practise tracks are tune only, without words, and slower than the piece is usually sung. The first has all three voices together, then one track for each of the three voices. The words are below.

- Regina Caeli Jubila – SAB together
- Regina Caeli Jubila – Soprano only
- Regina Caeli Jubila – Alto only
- Regina Caeli Jubila – Bass only (all men)
