## **Water Matters**

The story of a 7 year old Japanese child who went missing in a dangerous forest area after he was temporarily abandoned by his parents for misbehaving became an international news story recently. There was much comment and criticism of the parents and lively discussions in the media about appropriate and inappropriate ways of disciplining young children. But the most remarkable aspect of the story was that a child so young could survive in the wild for 7 days and emerge from his ordeal relatively unscathed. The outcome would probably have been much more dramatic but for the simple fact that he found a shelter where there was a tap with running water.

Not every child or adult on our planet today has the luxury of running water in the home or even access to clean drinking water. In many African and Asian countries, it falls to the children to walk to the nearest well or river, often several miles away, every morning and evening, before and after school. Frequent droughts often cause these sources to dry up. I have seen women and children trying to wash themselves and their clothes in the muddy pools of a drying river bed. Polluted and untreated water is the cause of many life-threatening illnesses but they have no choice..

It is hard for us to imagine what a severe water shortage is like. If our running water is undrinkable for any reason, we can go out and buy bottled water or the local authority will ensure households are supplied. But could this change? International experts warn us that we are on the brink of a global water crisis and that, if radical measures are not put in place urgently, there is no guarantee that water supplies will continue to provide adequately for our needs, even in the western world. The lack of safe drinking water has increased in the last two decades. There is no reason to think this trend will be reversed without urgent action.

The political wrangling and indignant outcry against the introduction of water charges in our own country show how difficult it is for a government to get this message across. Meanwhile, thousands of litres of precious water continue to leak into the ground from an inadequate and poorly resourced system. Would we use water more sparingly if we knew how much it was costing us? Perhaps not, so accustomed are we to almost never having to ration our use of this most essential of all the world's resources.

Pope Francis constantly urges us to listen to the cry of the poor, an invitation to all responsible Christians to "think globally and act locally". In this jubilee year of our parish, is there one small step we can all take in our homes or work places to grow in awareness of the need to use this precious gift with gratitude and moderation?




