The Eucharist and Community



Sadly, often people in church are just so many strangers packed into the one space. They are there simultaneously but are not really together. What you have is a collection of isolated individuals. And like strangers on a bus, they escape into themselves and become anonymous to one another.

People don't have a sense of being community, of being the Body of Christ, of being branches of the one true Vine. Hence, they can come to church and leave again without meeting anyone. Whatever they take away, it won't be from one another. Nor will they give anything to one another.

How did this situation come about? Partly because of lack of community participation in the Eucharist. In the days of the Latin Mass, each followed the Mass quietly and privately, often involved in private prayers and devotions of their own.

This is not the way it is meant to be. Even on a human level we have a deep need for community. Loneliness is a major complaint today. The world is crying out for community. This is where the Eucharist can be a tremendous help, and a challenge too.

We are meant to form a single body because we all share in the one loaf. The Eucharist is the sign and source of our unity. Without it there is no people of God, no community of faith, no Church. We can't be truly in communion with Jesus without being in communion with one another.

During the week we are necessarily scattered. But here we are brought together. Here we are the Body of Christ made visible. Here we are one family under God. Love should be the atmosphere we breathe here.

There should be no such thing as a solitary Christian. The fruit that Christ desires from us is primarily that of unity. By this all will know that we are living branches of the Vine - by the bond that exists between us and the care we show for one another.

Building community is not that hard. It just takes ordinary friendliness. The first step is to become acquainted.

By inviting us to partake of the sacred food of the Eucharist, Jesus makes us his companions and friends. And in doing so, we ought to become companions and friends to one another

When we depart from here, we must take out into the world some of the warmth we have experienced here.

World Meeting of Families

22 to 26 August 2018

Theme: “The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World”

Pope Francis has chosen Dublin to host the **9th World Meeting of Families** during 2018, from the 22nd to 26th August 2018, with the theme “*The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World*”. It is hoped that the Pope (or his successor) will attend. This Gathering is expected to attract thousands of Catholic families from around globe to Ireland. It is hoped that this very special pastoral initiative will present all of us in the Church with the opportunity and the challenge to renew, support and strengthen Irish families in their commitment to their faith.

To support hosting this event the Irish Bishops intend to hold three annual national Church collections in 2016, 2017, and 2018, the first of which takes place next weekend 28th and 29th May 2016, replacing the Share collection.

The World Meeting of Families is a pastoral initiative of St. John Paul II, held every three years, and coordinated by the Pontifical Council for the Family, it is the largest universal gathering of Catholic families and brings together families from all over the world in faith

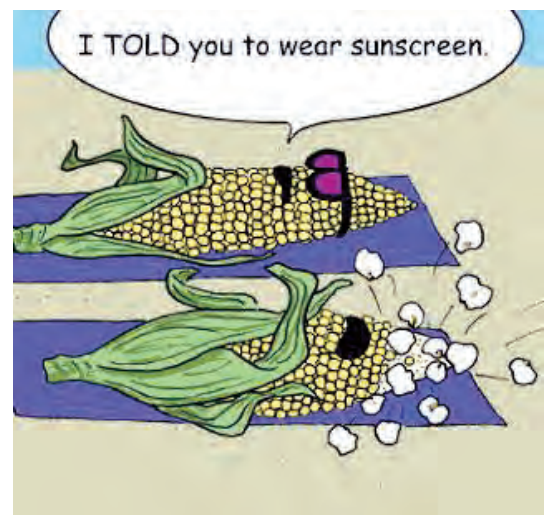
