Ascension of Our Lord, Year A, May 28th 2017. Bulletin No: 1165.

The Ascension of Jesus is a mystery which is beyond words. The following illustration may go some way in helping us to understand what we are celebrating on this great feast.

Lech Walesa worked for years as an electrician in the Gdansk shipyards. During those years he and his fellow workers founded the movement which became known as *Solidarity*. Walesa became its leader bringing him into open conflict with the communist rulers.

Eventually the workers won out, the communist regime collapsed and democracy returned to Poland. Then, on December 9th 1990, something amazing happened. Walesa was elected first president of a free and democratic Poland.

It was a great honour for Walesa. His fellow workers were delighted. They too felt honoured because of their association with him. However, there was sadness too. They knew that it would change for ever the way they related to him. They knew they were losing him. However, they were hoping that he would not forget them and that he would help them from his new and more influential position.

During the years of his public ministry Jesus ate and drank in the company of the apostles. They experienced his love and care every day. In many ways he was just like themselves. Did the Ascension mean that he had left them and ended all this intimacy and familiarity? Yes and

Jesus would no longer be physically present to them, but he hadn't left them entirely. He had simply taken on a new role, assumed a new position. After many years of humble labour and dangerous struggle, Walesa achieved the great honour of being elected president of his country. After years of struggle on earth, Jesus was crowned with glory by his heavenly Father, and became Lord of all creation. For those who have faith, Jesus is closer to them than ever, and in a better position to help them.

The first Christians understood this very well. They knew that Jesus was still with them, even if not in the same way as before. They believed he still shared their lives, and that death would mean being united with him in glory forever.

Parish Consultation Tuesday 6th June 7 p.m.


