Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A, November 19th 2017. Bulletin No: 1190.

In the Gospel Christ talks about three people who were given different talents. He commends the first two because they used their talents. And he censures the third because he buried his talent.

When Christ talks about talents, we must not think he means a musical talent or a footballing talent. Such talents are important, and all credit to those who possess them, develop them, and use them. But they are outrageously over-valued and over-rewarded in our times. Christ's parable goes a lot deeper. Ultimately the only thing that matters is what we make of ourselves.

However, we are mistaken if we think it is about making something of oneself in a materialistic sense, though this is not ruled out. The woman spoken about in the First Reading could hardly be described as being either successful or famous. Yet she is held up as a model. Why? Because of the kind of person she is... industrious, caring, wise and virtuous. She possesses something more valuable than wealth or beauty. She possesses a loving heart. She has put her talents at the service of her family, her neighbours, and the poor. Hence, she has the respect of the entire community.

Life is God's gift to us. What we do with life is our gift to God.


New Pilgrim Path Website of the Week.


ALPHA & OMEGA

#REDWEDNESDAY | 22.NOV.17


