

## Sacrifice?

The young man who came to Jesus did so because he admired Him—he called Him 'Good Master'. It's easy to gain admirers, but difficult to find people willing to make sacrifices. When Jesus asked him to give up his wealth and become his disciple, it proved too big a sacrifice for him. He went away sad. Why sad? Because the challenge Jesus issued to him caused a vision of true greatness to flare up in his young mind. He found this vision exciting but too costly. He knew that in turning his back on Jesus, he was turning his back on this vision too. So he went away sad.

And Jesus let him go. He respected his freedom. There is no point in forcing people to make sacrifices. If you take things away from them, they are impoverished. But if you can get them to give them up freely, they are enriched. People are essentially good. But this goodness has to be awakened and called forth if they are to enter the kingdom of love.

It is not what we receive that makes us great but what we give away. It is by giving that we grow. There is a danger that religion can become too easy. All the great religions teach that there is no reward without renunciation, without paying a price.

Jesus promised an earthly reward too to those who follow him—the reward of friendships, and of a life of purpose and meaning. Paradoxically it's not an easy life but rather a life of sacrifice, that leads to fulfilment and joy.
