Gaudete Sunday

Violet is the liturgical colour of Lent and Advent. Yet, in both holy seasons, over half way through, we discover the bright colour of rose in the liturgy... but only for one Sunday. The Sunday in Lent is called Laetare Sunday and in Advent Gaudete Sunday. Both these Latin words Gaudete and Laetare, (from the Entrance Antiphons at Mass) are translated, "Rejoice!"



Like Lent, Advent is a penitential season, so the priest normally wears purple vestments. But on Gaudete Sunday, having passed the midpoint of Advent, the Church lightens the mood a little, and the priest may wear rose vestments. For the same reason the third candle of the Advent wreath, which is first lit on Gaudete Sunday, is traditionally rose-colored. Having arrived at the midpoint of Advent we celebrate the nearness of the Lord and the change in colour provides us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation — especially prayer and fasting — for Christmas.
