## **FEASTDAYS** this week:

## Mon 14th: Ss Cyril & Methodius.

St Cyril (826-69) and Methodius (815-85) a bishop, were brothers from Greece. They preached the Gospel in Moravia using their own translation of the Scriptures and the liturgy in the local language. These translations into Slavonic were in an alphabet, now called Cyrillic, which they devised. They are honoured as apostles of the Slavic peoples and in 1980 Pope John Paul II declared them Patrons of Europe.
