Jesus lives his life facing real temptations and that is a measure of his humanity. As we enter Lent we ask ourselves how we face those temptations too.

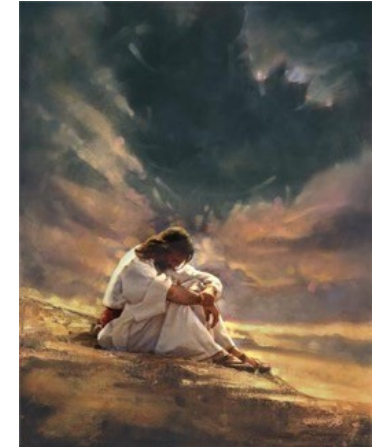
When times get rough and we feel hungry and alone, do we still trust in God?

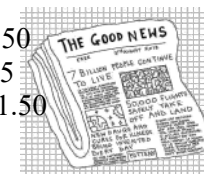
