On Holy Thursday, at the request of the Holy Father, there was a collection for the Holy Land, ('Pro Terra Sancta'), for which we thank you.


We also held a collection on Divine Mercy Sunday for Persecuted Christians (ACN) we thank you for your generosity as always.

He was the founder of two religious institutes of religious brothers: the Congregation of Christian Brothers and the Presentation Brothers.
