Commitment

We see a fine example of commitment in the First Reading when Elijah came to call Elisha to succeed him as prophet. We have a better example of commitment in the Gospel concerning Jesus himself. There we read how he set his face towards Jerusalem. That decision called for great courage and commitment, because he knew that rejection, betrayal and death awaited him there. But the Father had given him the task of bringing salvation to his brothers and sisters. He would not opt out now. Thus he has given an example to his followers of the kind of dedication that is required.

This kind of commitment is a great challenge. At times the path will be hard and strewn with obstacles. But we may have more to fear when the path is easy and littered with attractions, because then we are tempted to dally along the way, and run the risk of being sidetracked.

Today we live in the age of the 'drop-out'. The Lord still calls people today, and there still are those who respond. Some people are called to dedicate themselves totally and in a 'professional' way to the following of Christ. But not all Christians are called to follow Christ in this way.

What does following of Christ mean for the ordinary person? It means to be called to be Christian where you are and in your chosen profession. There are more ways than one of serving Christ and his Gospel. The call is in the first instance to discipleship rather than to apostolate.


