An Open Invitation

Each of us, if we got down to it, could draw up quite a long list of things, which we know in our hearts, we should do, or should not do, but which we refuse to look at. And we have no shortage of excuses. They spring up to our defence like over-enthusiastic security guards.



The excuses that kept the invited guests from attending the wedding feast, weren't all bad, in most cases they were perfectly good ones. But this is precisely what makes them so dangerous. We don't see them as posing a threat.

The greatest danger facing us is not that we might abandon God and turn to evil, but rather that we might just ignore his invitation. To ignore God's invitation altogether is the worst form of refusal. It implies indifference. Indifferent people are the hardest to convert.

We are invited not merely as individuals but as a community. It is the banquet of the new People of God, namely, the Christian community.

We don't have to earn our place at the banquet. We are invited. It seems so simple to come to an unearned banquet.
