### The Kindness of Jesus

Jesus' gesture in touching the leper was a small thing in itself. But that small gesture meant the world to the leper. He felt he was a human being after all. His body was horribly wounded by leprosy. But his spirit was even more deeply wounded - by the sense of having been rejected and abandoned by everyone, including God. By touching him Jesus healed his wounded spirit. Then he cured his wounded body. Now the man was wholly cured.

But Jesus wasn't finished with him yet. Knowing the great sorrow and indignity he had suffered as a result of family separation and abandonment, he eased his return to society by telling him to show himself to a priest. (the priests were the only people who could officially authenticate his cure)

Kindness is almost as important to a sick person as medicine. Jesus asked the leper to keep quiet about his cure. But he broadcast everywhere what Jesus had done for him. It wasn't just the fact that Jesus had cured him that he spoke about, but the astonishing kindness and respect with which he had treated him.

Jesus reached out his a loving and healing hand towards a pariah. He challenges us his followers to reach out to those society rejects today. It's amazing what people can do for people.
