Coming out into the Light

St John says, 'Whoever does what is true (right), comes out into the light. Coming to the light is conditional on doing what is right. It's not the one who speculates about the truth but the one who does the truth who comes to the light. The shortest journey to the light is by doing the good/right thing.

So what must we do? We must try to ensure that the light of truth and justice shines in our words and deeds. It is not enough for us just to avoid doing evil. We must do the good and right deed. If we do, our lives will become luminous.

People who have come to know the love of God do not deny the darkness, but they choose not to live in it. They trust in the light that shines in the darkness, and know that a little bit of light can dispel a lot of darkness. And the light of Christ is such that no darkness can overpower it.

Evil people hate the light because it reveals themselves to themselves. They hate goodness because it reveals their badness; they hate industry because it reveals their laziness. They will destroy the light, the goodness, the love in order to avoid the pain of self-discovery.

It's sad when people reject the light, when they refuse God's offer of love. But how happy are those who choose to walk in the light of God's love. The cross is the ultimate manifestation of God's love for us.
