The Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit

Pentecost is a feast of the Church that celebrates the third person of the Triune God — the Holy Spirit, which descended upon the first disciples of Jesus

In the story of how the Holy Spirit descended upon the first Christians, a “strong, driving” wind filled the room where the apostles were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other. The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts that were needed to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills Christ’s promise that the Apostles would be “clothed with power” before going out to spread the Gospel (Luke 24:46-49).

If we are led by the Spirit and open to God’s gifts, the fruits of the Holy Spirit will be evident in our lives and in this way people will see that the Holy Spirit is active in our lives, in our work, in the way we treat others and in the way we serve the community of the Church as the practical living out of the gift of the Holy Spirit given at Confirmation.

Choose from the baskets in the Church, a Gift of the Holy Spirit or a Fruit of the Holy Spirit. The Gifts are: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. The Fruits are: Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self control.
