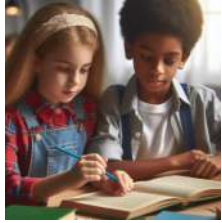
**New Pilgrim Path**

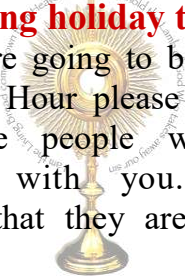
**Summer Flowers**

**The Good Shepherd**

Jesus was in such demand that he and the apostles scarcely had time to eat. However, at some point he decided that enough was enough, and took the apostles off to a quiet place for a break.



However, things didn’t work out as planned. The people followed them. The way Jesus reacted tells us a lot about the kind of person he was. Far from getting annoyed, he was moved with pity for them, and taught them at some length. He saw that they were leaderless. The official teachers had no time for the ordinary people. But Jesus had time for them. This is why they flocked to him. He is contrasted with the shepherds Jeremiah was talking about in the first reading who neglected their sheep.

Caring is at the heart of the Gospel. A Christian who doesn't care is like a lamp that doesn't give light. Caring brings its own rewards in terms of the peace and joy that descends on us afterwards. All of us a capable of caring. Caring calls for awareness, sensitivity and unselfishness.

The need for caring people is great. Neglect is widespread in our society. There are many in our world who are like sheep without a shepherd. To be able to care is a sign of spiritual well being. When we care, we are living the Gospel
