October - the month of the Holy Rosary

Here is how to pray the Rosary...

The Rosary begins with the Apostles Creed, followed by one Our Father, three Hail Marys (traditionally offered for an increase in faith, hope, and charity for those praying the Rosary), a Glory Be, and, if desired, the Fatima Prayer. Next come the five decades, each consisting of one Our Father, ten Hail Marys, a Glory Be, and, if desired, the Fatima Prayers. Conclude the Rosary with the Hail Holy Queen.



November is traditionally the month in which the Church remembers Her dead, and in a special way we are invited to remember family and friends who have died, especially those who have passed in the previous year.

The November List is available from the Church for you to complete and return. They can be returned via the basket collection on Sundays, to the parish office or via the offerings box in the back of the church.
