

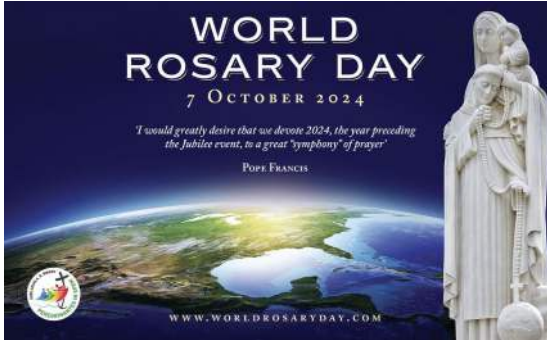

**The Holy Spirit, an Encourager**

According to scripture, God is the source of every comfort and encouragement. He wants to work through people to provide this amazing ministry but thankfully He sends us His Spirit when people fail.

God comforts us in our time of need so we might then comfort others in theirs. God always expects us to give away what He gives us. This is a spiritual law and is the way to keep a steady flow of whatever we need coming into our lives. God first gives to us and His Word says we are to give and it will be given unto us in an overflowing abundance. The more we encourage others, the more encouraged we will be ourselves. If we merely received God's comfort in our time of need, but then don't bother to encourage others, we will soon find that our fountain of comfort is no longer flowing when we need it.
