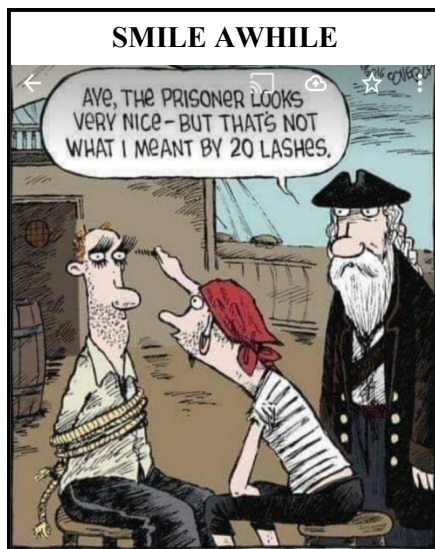

A Handbook for Christians

Here each Sunday we hear the words of Jesus, words that were written down by the early Christians, and which have been preserved for us over the centuries by the Church. Thus Christ's promise has come true: 'Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.'

The Gospel consists of a series of stories, all of which coalesce to form one great story - the story of Jesus. While we all like to listen to a story, we grow tired if we are told the same story over and over again. When that happens we switch off. The same thing can happen with the Gospel story. It may come across as old, stale and lifeless.

How can we combat that stale and weary sense of the familiar? We have to try to hear the story afresh, indeed, as for the very first time. The Gospel is the greatest story ever told. And we need to recapture the wonder of it. We need to release the energy contained in it, if we are to experience the power it has to charm, surprise, shock, challenge and inspire.

We need to hear it in such a way that we are drawn into it, and hear our own stories as we listen to it. When that happens, our stories merge with that of the Gospel, and are illuminated by it.

Everything we need is contained in the Gospels. Here we have the words of Jesus himself. Those who make this book their teacher will never go astray.
