2025 Jubilee Year of Hope officially opens on
Christmas Eve at 7pm, with the rite of Opening of the
Holy Door of the Papal Basilica of St. Peter by the Holy
Father, who will then preside over the celebration of the
Night Mass of the Lord's Birth.

The Catholic Holy Year ordinarily occurs once every 25 years, and is a
chance for the faithful to visit holy sites, perform pious works, and have
their sins remitted. Pope Francis announced the theme for the Jubilee as
'Pilgrims of Hope' (*Spes non Confundit - Hope Does Not
Disappoint*). Everyone is invited to participate in this special year of
