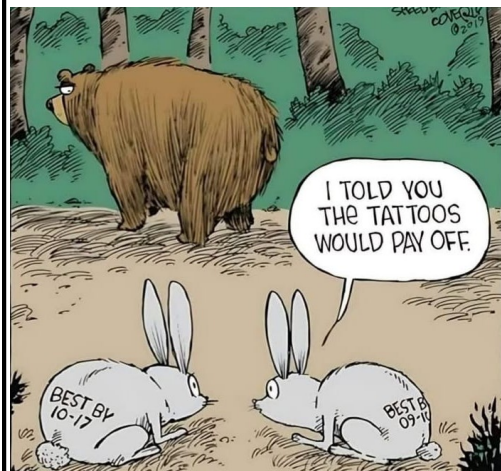

## Cana for All

What Jesus did at Cana was not a once-off thing. It happened throughout the whole of his ministry. The Gospels are full of examples. His presence changed beyond recognition the lives of those who came into contact with him.

For sinners he changed separation from God into friendship with God. For the widow of Nain he changed tears into joy. For Zacchaeus he changed selfishness into love. For the thief on Calvary he changed despair into hope. And on Easter morning he changed death into life.

He continues to do this for those who believe in him and follow him. He transforms our lives. He offers us something we pine for but can't achieve on our own, namely, a share in the life of God. Material things are not enough. Jesus brings another dimension to life. He brings a joy that the world cannot give.

He asked the servants to draw out the water that had turned into wine, and to take it to the steward. Jesus always used human intermediaries to convey his gifts. He asks us to share with others the gifts he has shared with us.

St Paul says that gifts are for service (Second Reading). Though there are many 'charisms' or spiritual gifts, all come from the same Spirit and should be used for the building up of the community.

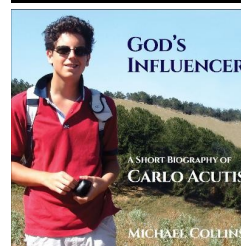
