The image of a tree planted by the waterside is a beautiful image. Perhaps we don't appreciate the full thrust of it when we live in a country that has an abundance of rainfall!!

In a land that suffers from drought, water is everything. If you are travelling through a drought-stricken country, occasionally you may see a ribbon of green vegetation running down a hillside. This is an infallible sign of the presence of a stream, often an underground one. The ribbon of green stands out because it contrasts sharply with the surrounding landscape, which is almost totally barren.

This is the kind of full and fruitful life that is promised to those who follow the way of the Lord. Those who trust in God are like a tree planted by the waterside. But people can't be forced. Even God refuses to force people to do his will. Our freedom is sacred to God. We are the only creatures who can say 'no' to God. But we are also the only creatures who can say 'yes' to God. When we say 'yes' to God, our lives are blessed, and we will bear fruit in due season.

The First Reading and the Psalm prepare us for the Gospel. There Jesus takes up the theme of the blessedness of those who put their trust in God and follow God's way, rather than the ways of the world. They are truly blessed even though they may be poor, hungry and persecuted.
