Rite of Election of Catechumens St Mary's Pro-Cathedral

Sunday, March 9th, 2025 at 3pm

The Rite of Election is an annual event in the Archdiocese of Dublin. It's the joyful moment in the Church's year when Catechumens who have been preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist are formally called by name by the Archbishop.

A Catechumen is an unbaptised adult person, and during this season of Lent, many parishes are preparing to welcome Catechumens into full communion with the Catholic Church.


