SPECIAL COLLECTION PRO TERRA SANCTA

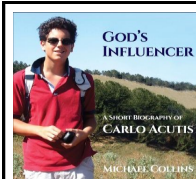

The Triumph of Love

Each year on this Sunday we read an account of the Passion of Jesus. As we listen to it, we are reminded of the cowardice of the followers who abandoned him in his hour of greatest need, of the wickedness of the religious leaders who plotted his death, and of the cruelty of the soldiers who carried out his execution. We need to be reminded of these things, because dark evil sleeps in us all. But that is not the purpose of the Passion reading. We hear too much bad news as it is.

The emphasis is not there. The emphasis is on Jesus, the central character in the story. What we are remembering is the courage, the fidelity, and the sheer goodness of Jesus. In order to convey the brightness of light it is necessary to show the depth of the surrounding darkness. Against the darkness of Calvary, Jesus' goodness shines all the more brightly.

We see how, in the midst of His Passion, Jesus cared about others - about the women of Jerusalem who sympathised with Him, about the thief and of course about His mother. It speaks volumes that from the depth of His own pain He could feel the pain of others and reach out to them. He died praying for those who put Him to death.

We are saved, not by His sufferings, but by His love.
