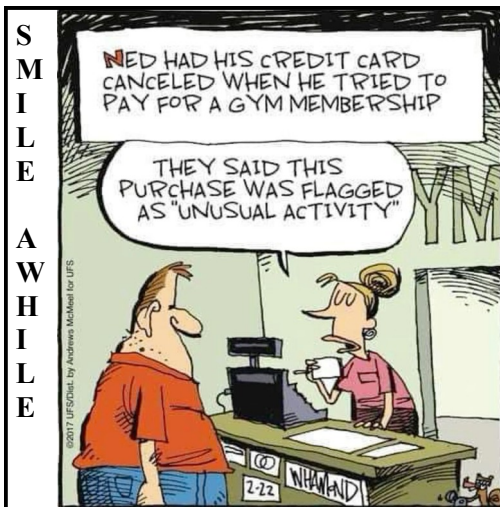

Witnesses for Christ

Before leaving his apostles Jesus commissioned them to preach the Gospel to the whole world. In order to help them carry out that mission he promised to send them the Holy Spirit. On Pentecost day he fulfilled that promise.

The task of preaching the Gospel to the world now depends on us. We are Christ's witnesses. It's a great privilege but a daunting task. However, we can also rely on the help of the Holy Spirit. We witness by professing our faith. This could include explaining it and defending it.

1. There is the witness of *words*. We witness by professing our faith. This could include explaining it and defending it.
2. There is the witness of *deeds*. An apple tree that never produced an apple would be a poor witness for the orchard. Even one good apple speaks.
3. Then there is the witness of *one's life*. Trees witness to life just by being. Tall, straight, motionless, they are silent yet eloquent witnesses to life. Flowers bear witness to beauty simply by being what they are. And Christians bear witness by what they are. The most eloquent sermon is the silent sermon of example. Today people no longer want to listen to sermons on the faith. They want to see the Gospel in action.

The witness of a Christian life is more powerful than any argument.

FEASTDAYS this week

Tuesday 3rd June: St Kevin, abbot.

*St Kevin (498? -3 June 618) was a native of Leinster and grew up in
Kilnamanagh, where he received his early religious formation. Wishing
to be a hermit, he crossed the mountains to Gendalough and settled in
Disert Caoimhghin at the foot of the upper lake but disciples began to
gather round him. Gradually the great monastic settlement grew and
spread through the glen after his death in 618 A.D. St Kevin is the
patron saint of our parish school and is also the name of the presbytery
which houses the parish office. The other presbytery is named
St Petroc's, for us perhaps, a lesser know saint. St Petroc was welsh and
is associated with monasteries in Devon and Cornwall. His connection
to St Kevin is that he is alleged to have been a teacher of his.*
