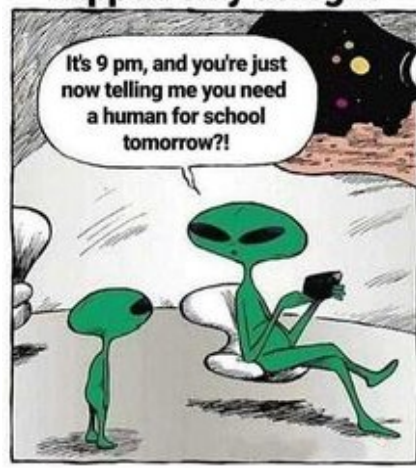
Sacristan Vacancy Church of the Apostles Ballybrack
