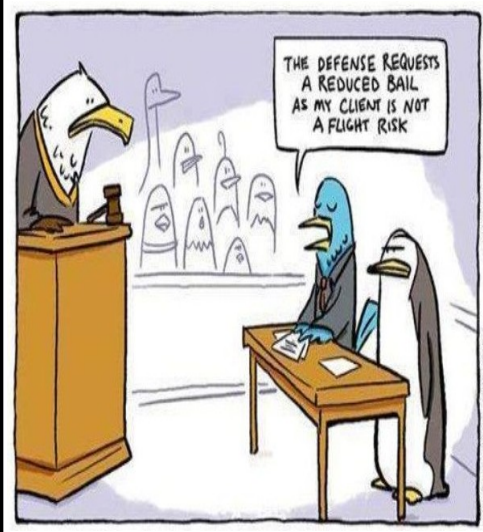

Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, a solemn reminder of the mystery of salvation through Christ's sacrifice. It commemorates both the discovery of the True Cross by St. Helena in the fourth century and the dedication of the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. More than a historical event, it is a liturgical celebration of the victory of the Cross, which transformed an instrument of suffering into the sign of redemption and eternal life.

The Church invites the faithful to “lift high the Cross” not as a symbol of defeat, but as the throne of Christ's glory. On the Cross, Christ emptied Himself in perfect obedience and love, reconciling heaven and earth. In venerating the Cross, Christians affirm that true power is found not in domination, but in sacrificial love. The feast calls us to embrace our own crosses with hope, uniting them to Christ's, and to find in them the path to resurrection.

The exaltation of the Cross is thus an invitation to gratitude and courage. By contemplating the Cross, believers are reminded of God's immense mercy and are strengthened to bear witness to the Gospel in daily life.

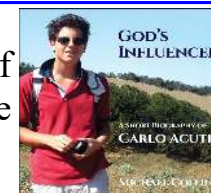
