Carlo Acutis - A Saint for Our Times

Carlo Acutis, often called the "Cyber Apostle of the Eucharist," was an Italian teenager whose deep faith and love for technology made him a remarkable witness of holiness in modern times. Born in London in 1991 and raised in Milan, Carlo displayed from a young age a special devotion to the Eucharist and the Virgin Mary. He attended daily Mass, prayed the rosary, and dedicated himself to serving others, especially the poor and marginalized.

What made Carlo especially unique was his ability to merge faith with technology. Gifted with strong computer skills, he created a website cataloguing Eucharistic miracles from around the world. His aim was to help people grow in their love and reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, which he often described as his "highway to heaven." Despite being a normal teenager who enjoyed soccer, video games, and time with friends, Carlo placed Christ at the centre of everything he did.

At the age of fifteen, Carlo was diagnosed with an aggressive form of leukemia. He offered his suffering for the Pope and the Church, showing remarkable maturity and trust in God. On October 12, 2006, he passed away, leaving behind a legacy that continues to inspire countless people.

In 2020, Pope Francis beatified Carlo Acutis in Assisi, where he is buried. His life is a powerful reminder that holiness is possible for everyone, even in the digital age. Carlo's example challenges young people to use technology responsibly, in ways that spread truth, beauty, and love.

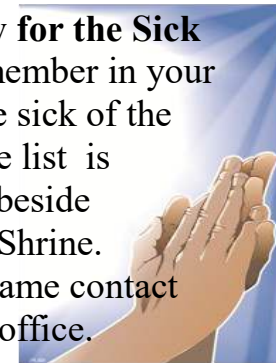

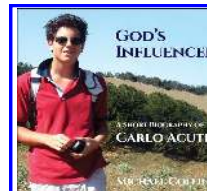
