

Ten lepers cry out to Jesus for mercy, and He heals them all. Yet only one - a Samaritan - returns to give thanks. This powerful story reminds us of the importance of gratitude, not just as good manners, but as an act of faith. The nine who were healed went on their way, rejoicing perhaps in their restored health, but they missed something deeper. The Samaritan, recognizing the source of his healing, turned back to praise God. In doing so, he received not only physical restoration but also spiritual salvation: "Your faith has saved you."

Gratitude opens our hearts to God's presence. When we give thanks, we acknowledge that everything we have - health, family, faith, and life itself - is a gift. In a world often focused on entitlement or self-sufficiency, this Gospel invites us to pause and return to the Lord with hearts full of praise. True faith is not only asking for help but remembering to thank the One who provides it.

This Sunday, we are called to be like the grateful leper: to notice God's blessings, to return to Christ in thanksgiving, and to live each day as a response of love and gratitude.
