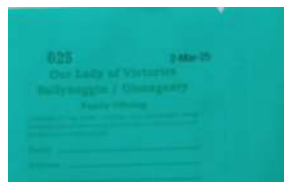


The Benefits of Tax Reclaim

Traceable donations to charities over the amount €250 per annum qualify for the tax reclaim scheme operated by Revenue. Any qualifying tax payer can augment their donations to charities by completing the form CHY4 (valid for 5 years). Here is a little case study to illustrate the 'every penny counts' principle

John attends Mass every Sunday and makes an offering to the First & Second Collections of €5 via the envelope provided noting his name and eircode on the envelope.
