He Will Wipe Away Every Tear: Hope for All Souls

Today, the Church pauses in solemn remembrance of all who have gone before us - our loved ones, friends, and all souls who rest in God's mercy. All Souls' Day is not only a time of mourning but also a celebration of hope, founded on the promise that God "will destroy death forever and wipe away the tears from all faces" (Isaiah 25:8)

The psalmist proclaims, "I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living." This faith allows us to look beyond grief, trusting that the same Lord who gave us life will welcome us into eternal communion with Him. St. Paul reminds us that "while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." God's love does not abandon us in death - it redeems, restores, and leads us to everlasting peace.

In Luke's Gospel, Jesus' compassion for the widow of Nain shows us the heart of God - a love that meets sorrow with mercy and transforms loss into life.
