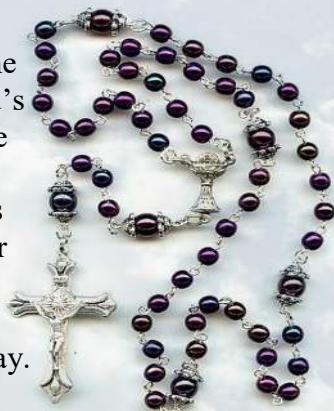

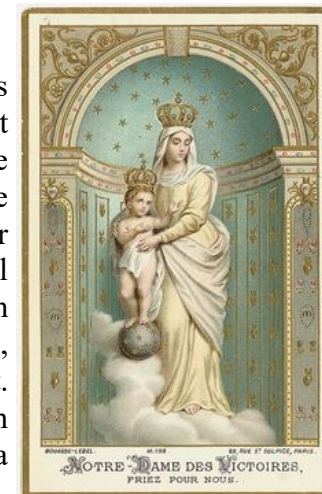

Our Lady of the Rosary

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated each year on October 7th. This feast honours the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title "Our Lady of the Rosary," highlighting her role in guiding the faithful to Christ through prayer and devotion. The rosary itself is a powerful prayer that combines vocal prayer with meditation on the key events of Christ's life, known as the mysteries. Tradition holds that St. Dominic promoted the rosary in the thirteenth century as a spiritual weapon against sin and a path to deeper faith.



The feast was instituted by Pope St. Pius V in 1571 following the victory of Christian forces at the Battle of Lepanto. At the time, Europe faced a grave threat from the Ottoman Empire, and the Pope called on all Christians to pray the rosary for protection. The triumph at Lepanto was attributed to Mary's intercession, and the feast was established to commemorate both the victory and the power of prayer.

This feast reminds Catholics of the importance of the rosary as a means of contemplation, peace, and spiritual strength. It invites the faithful to entrust themselves to Mary, who always leads souls closer to Christ. Through this devotion, believers find courage, hope, and unity in faith.
