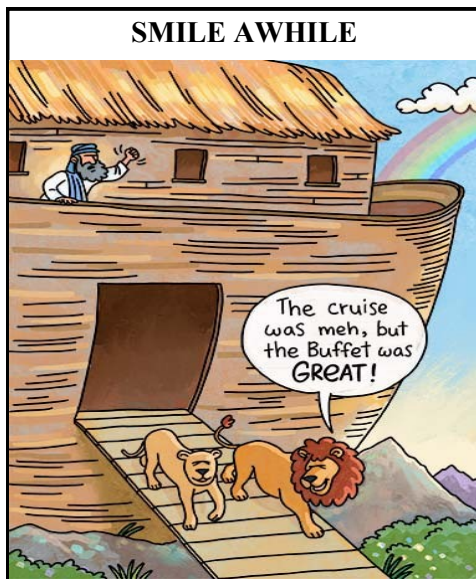

CHRIST ^{the} KING

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe is a title that highlights both the majesty and the humility of Christ's reign. His kingship stands in striking contrast to earthly models of power. Rather than ruling through force or intimidation, Jesus exercises authority through self-giving love, revealed most clearly in His willingness to suffer and die on the cross. The crown of thorns and the cross itself become symbols of a kingdom rooted in redemption, mercy, and truth.

This vision of Christ's kingship invites reflection on the kind of reign He brings into the world. His dominion is marked by justice, compassion, and reconciliation. It advances wherever people choose forgiveness over vengeance, kindness over indifference, and hope over despair. Acknowledging Jesus as King challenges believers to examine the values that guide their choices and to resist the "kingdoms" of pride, greed, and self-exaltation that compete for their allegiance.

Though His kingship is universal—embracing all nations, cultures, and moments in history—it is also deeply personal. Christ seeks to transform hearts as much as societies, calling individuals to walk in truth and participate in the renewal of the world. To call Jesus King of the Universe is to affirm that His love defines the ultimate purpose of creation and that His victory over sin and death establishes a kingdom that endures beyond all earthly powers.

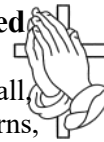
