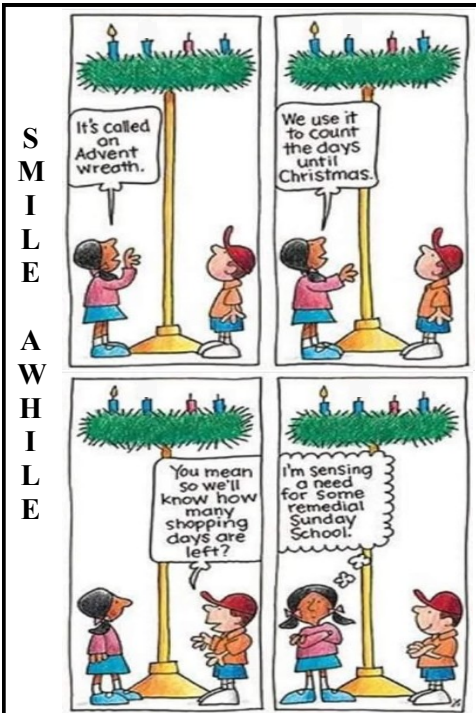

Dublin Celebrates its 'New' Cathedral

On 14 November 2025, the Feast of St Laurence O'Toole, St Mary's Pro-Cathedral in Dublin was formally elevated to full cathedral status by Pope Leo XIV. This momentous decision coincided with the church's bicentenary - it was originally dedicated on 14 November 1825, on the very same feast day.



The “Pro-” in its name, short for pro tempore (“for the time being”), reflected its provisional status for two centuries. By granting it the permanent title of St Mary's Cathedral, the papal decree ends this long-standing provisional status.



The Feast of St Laurence O'Toole is always a day of celebration in the Diocese. Priests from the four corners of the Diocese gather to celebrate Mass in honour of our Diocese' Patron Saint.

Singing at the Mass this year were a choir comprised the Palestrina choir and a schools choir of children from the schools under the patronage of St Laurence O'Toole. Of special note was a young parishioner of ours, Cillian de Fréin, who sang the psalm at the Mass. Well done Cillian, we are all very proud of you!

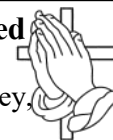
