Envelopes for Christmas Dues will be available at the back of the Church.




We thank all parishioners for their support of the Dues Collection. Proceeds from the Dues are used to support the priests of the Diocese and also those who are sick or retired.

Gaudete: Joy That Waits with Hope

The Third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, invites us into a quiet but profound joy - a joy born not from what we already possess, but from what we faithfully await. Isaiah paints a world transformed: deserts blooming, the weak strengthened, and the oppressed redeemed. It is a vision of hope that pushes beyond present difficulties, reminding us that God's promise is not an abstract comfort but a real future already taking root.

"Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near!"
1 Thess 5:16-17

Gaudete Sunday



James urges patience, the kind that is neither passive nor resigned but active and steadfast. Like a farmer who trusts the unseen work beneath the soil, we are called to trust that God's purposes are unfolding even when we cannot yet see the harvest. This patience is itself a form of hope - an orientation of the heart that chooses confidence over fear.

In the Gospel, John the Baptist's question - "Are you the one who is to come?" - echoes our own moments of uncertainty. Jesus answers not with theories but with signs: the blind see, the lame walk, the poor receive good news. His works reveal that God's kingdom is not distant; it is breaking in now.

Advent joy, then, is not naïve optimism. It is recognizing the evidence of God's renewing presence in small and surprising ways. Today we are invited to rejoice, not because everything is fulfilled, but because God is already at work, and the fullness of His promise draws near.
