


ADORATION OVER CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS



Awakened by the Voice in the Wilderness

The Second Sunday of Advent invites us into a posture of anticipation and renewal. The readings call us not only to wait for Christ's coming but to prepare our hearts in ways that transform daily life. Isaiah offers a vision of a world healed and made whole - a place where justice flourishes and peace is secure. His prophecy reminds us that God's promise is not distant; it is unfolding now, inviting our participation.



John the Baptist then appears in the Gospel as an urgent voice in the wilderness. His call to "Repent" is not to create fear but to awaken clarity. Repentance means turning toward the light, clearing away the distractions and habits that hinder us from welcoming Christ. John challenges us to examine our direction: Are we moving toward God's vision of justice and mercy, or settling into complacency and self-interest?

Advent is a season of holy tension - between what is and what God desires for us. On this second Sunday, we are invited to cultivate hope, not as wishful thinking but as trust in God's transforming work. As we light the second candle, may we recommit to preparing a straight path for the Lord and allow His presence to reshape our hearts and world.
