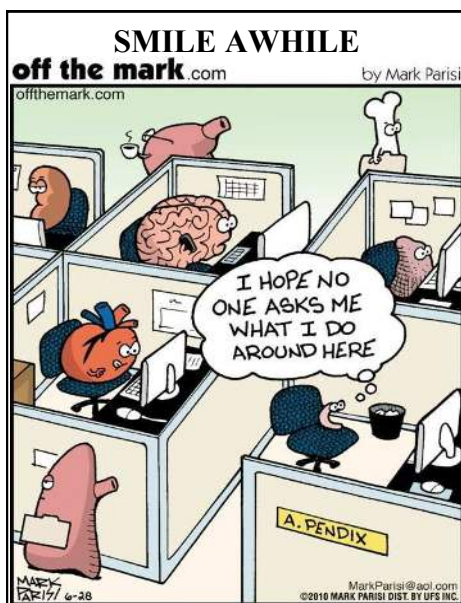

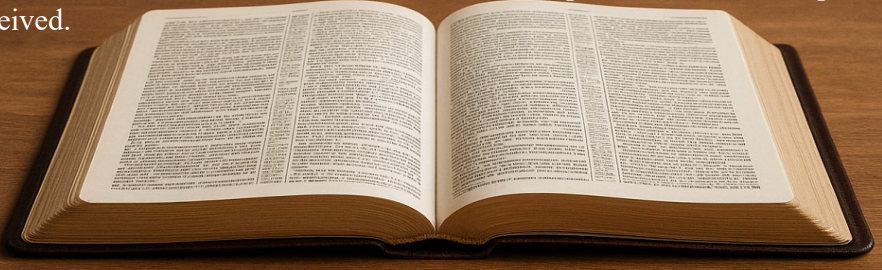
SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

Sunday of the Word of God invites the Church to slow down and listen again to the voice that speaks before we speak. It reminds us that Scripture is not an accessory to faith but its living heartbeat. When the Word is proclaimed, God is not recalling a distant past; he is addressing us now.

Too often we approach the Bible selectively, searching for verses that confirm what we already believe or skipping passages that unsettle us. The Word of God forms us precisely when it interrupts us, when it exposes our blindness and stretches our love. In listening, we learn humility: God speaks on his terms, not ours.

The Word also creates communion. It gathers believers across cultures, generations, and languages around the same saving story. When Scripture is read in the assembly, Christ himself becomes present, teaching and consoling his people. This listening trains us to recognize his voice beyond the church walls - in the poor, the wounded, and the forgotten.

Sunday of the Word of God sends us outward. The Bible is not meant to be admired and shelved, but embodied. What we hear must become what we live: mercy practiced, truth spoken, forgiveness offered. To honour the Word is to let it take flesh in us, so that our lives proclaim what our lips have received.
