Transfiguration

On this Second Sunday of Lent, the journey of faith is revealed as both invitation and challenge. In the call of Abraham, we see the courage required to leave behind security and step into an unknown future guided only by trust in God's promise. Faith begins not with full understanding, but with the decision to move forward when God calls.


The Gospel presents a moment of dazzling clarity as the disciples witness Jesus transfigured before them. For a brief time, fear gives way to wonder, and they glimpse the deeper truth of who He is. Yet this moment is not meant to be permanent. They cannot remain on the mountain. The vision strengthens them for the difficult road that lies ahead - a reminder that spiritual consolation prepares us for faithful living in ordinary and sometimes challenging circumstances.

Like the disciples, we experience moments when God feels close and faith seems effortless. But Lent reminds us that transformation happens not only in extraordinary experiences, but in daily perseverance. The command to "listen to him" invites us to centre our lives on Christ's voice amid distraction and uncertainty. Saint Paul's encouragement echoes this call, urging believers not to be discouraged by hardship but to rely on God's grace. Our journey of conversion unfolds gradually, shaped by trust rather than perfection.

As we continue through Lent, we are invited to walk forward with renewed confidence, carrying the light of the mountain into the realities of everyday life, trusting that God is continually leading us toward renewal and promise.
