Good on Trial

When something happens in a community and people are forced to take a stand, suddenly their hearts and minds are revealed. Some of them come out well, others are shown up in a poor light

The trial of Jesus was such an event. He was such a transparently good person that when he was put on trial, his innocence was obvious. When we look at the behaviour of the others we can see some ugly things. We see the fanaticism of Caiaphas and the religious leaders who plotted his death. We see the cold, calculating evil of Judas who betrayed him. We see the weakness of Peter who disowned him. We see the cruelty of Herod who mocked him. We see the cowardice of Pilate, who, though knowing he was innocent, signed his death warrant. We see the unthinking hostility of the mob who shouted, 'Crucify him!' we see the dutiful obedience of the soldiers who carried out the execution.

But we also see some lovely things. We see the compassion of Veronica who wiped his face. The courage of Simon of Cyrene who helped him to carry the cross. The sympathy of the women of Jerusalem who wept for him to the end, among these his mother and the disciple John.

It wasn't Jesus who was judged on that day. It was his disciples and especially his accusers and executioners. We too will be judged by our attitudes and actions.
