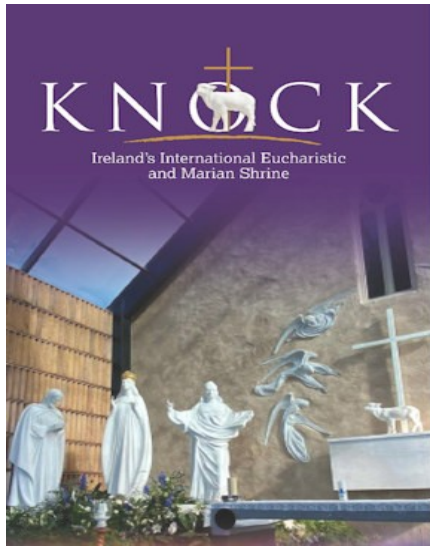

## Divine Mercy

Divine Mercy Sunday invites us to reflect deeply on trust, forgiveness, and the boundless mercy of God. In the Gospel, we encounter the disciples locked in fear, burdened by doubt and uncertainty. Yet Jesus enters their fear, not with judgment, but with peace: "Peace be with you." This moment reminds us that God does not wait for us to be perfect; He meets us exactly where we are, even in our weakness.



Thomas, often remembered for his doubt, becomes a powerful symbol of honest faith. He desires to see and touch before he believes. Rather than rejecting him, Jesus responds with patience and compassion. This shows us that questioning and struggling do not separate us from God—in fact, they can lead us closer to a deeper, more personal faith.

Divine Mercy Sunday calls us to trust in this mercy. It challenges us to let go of guilt, pride, and fear, and to open our hearts to God's forgiveness. At the same time, we are called to extend that same mercy to others. Forgiveness is not always easy, but it is the path to true freedom and healing.

Ultimately, this day reminds us that mercy is not just something we receive—it is something we are called to live and share every day.
