Third Sunday of Easter. Year A, 19th April 2026. Bulletin No: 1615.



This third Sunday of Easter invites us to walk with the disciples on the road to Emmaus. They are discouraged, confused, and grieving what they believed was lost. Like them, we often struggle to recognize hope when life doesn't unfold the way we expected. Yet, the Gospel reminds us that Christ draws near especially in those moments of disappointment, even if we fail to notice Him at first.

What changes everything is not just the explanation of Scripture, but the breaking of the bread. In that simple, sacred act, their eyes are opened. It's a powerful reminder that faith is not only about understanding with the mind, but encountering Christ in a real, living way - especially in the Eucharist and in everyday moments of grace.

This reflection challenges us to ask: where is Christ walking beside me right now, unnoticed? Often, He is present in conversations, in quiet nudges of conscience, or in unexpected kindness. The invitation is to slow down, to listen, and to allow our hearts to "burn within us" again.

The disciples didn't stay in Emmaus; they returned with urgency to share the good news. True encounter leads to action. If we recognize Christ in our lives, we are called to carry that hope to others, especially those still walking in doubt or despair.

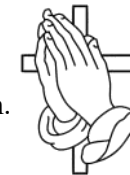
