## PENTECOST

Pentecost is often called the birthday of the Church, but it is also a reminder that faith is meant to be alive and active. Before the coming of the Holy Spirit, the disciples were confused, afraid, and uncertain about the future. They stayed hidden behind locked doors, unsure of what to do next. Yet when the Spirit came upon them, everything changed. They found courage, confidence, and a sense of purpose. This shows how God can transform weakness into strength.

One of the most striking parts of the Pentecost story is that people from different nations could understand the apostles speaking in their own languages. This teaches that God's message is for everyone. The Spirit breaks down barriers of fear, division, and prejudice. In a world where people are often separated by culture, politics, or religion, Pentecost reminds us that unity is possible when people listen with open hearts.

Pentecost also challenges Christians to use their gifts in service of others. The Holy Spirit gives wisdom, patience, kindness, and courage so that people can make a difference in everyday life. Small acts of love and understanding can reflect God's presence.

For us, Pentecost is a call to trust God more deeply and to live our faith with courage, hope, and compassion toward others every day.
