

Jesus prepares a place for us



The Fifth Sunday of Easter invites us to reflect on trust, direction, and our place in God's plan. In the Gospel, Jesus Christ reassures His disciples: "Do not let your hearts be troubled."

These words are not just comfort they are a challenge. Trust in Him is not passive; it requires belief even when the path ahead is unclear.

Jesus declares, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." This is direct and uncompromising. It means that following Him is not one option among many - it is the path to fullness of life. In a world that encourages self-reliance and endless choice, this message calls us to commit, to align our lives with something greater than ourselves.

The early Church, as seen in the first reading, also shows us that faith is lived in action. The apostles respond to real needs, ensuring that no one is neglected. Faith is not just belief - it is service, responsibility, and community. This Sunday challenges us to examine our own lives. Do we truly trust God, or only when it suits us? Are we living as part of His mission, or staying comfortable on the sidelines?

Christ prepares a place for us - but He also calls us to follow Him now.

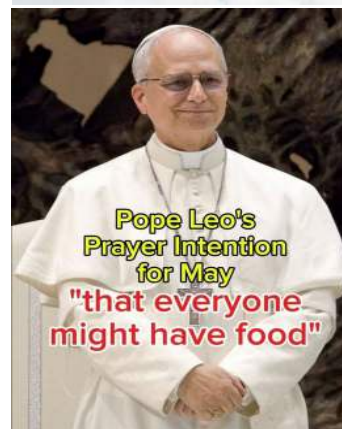
Next Weekend's Readings
