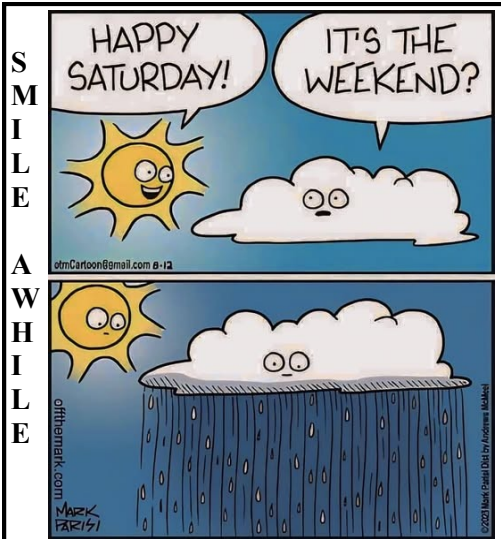

## Corpus Christi

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi invites us to reflect on the extraordinary gift of Christ's presence in the Eucharist. In today's readings we are reminded that God continually nourishes His people. In Deuteronomy, Moses recalls how God fed Israel with manna in the desert, teaching them that life depends not only on physical food but on every word that comes from God. This prepares us to understand the deeper nourishment offered by Jesus.

In St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, we hear that the cup of blessing and the bread we break are a participation in the Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol; it unites us with Jesus and with one another. As members of one Body, we are called to live in communion, showing love, forgiveness, and concern for those around us.

In the Gospel, Jesus declares, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven." He offers Himself completely so that we may have eternal life. The Eucharist is the greatest expression of God's love, a gift that sustains us on our journey of faith.

Corpus Christi challenges us not only to receive Christ in Holy Communion but also to become His presence in the world. Strengthened by the Bread of Life, we are sent out to serve others with generosity and compassion. In every Mass, Christ feeds us so that we may bring His love to a hungry world.
