Today's Gospel invites Christians to reflect on the condition of their hearts as they receive God's word. In the Parable of the Sower, Jesus explains that the seed is the Word of God, generously scattered among different kinds of soil. While the sower gives freely, the growth of the seed depends on the readiness of the soil.

There are times when people become distracted by worries, comfort, or the desire for success, allowing God's message to be choked by the "thorns" of daily life. At other times, they may hear His Word but fail to act on it, like seed falling on rocky ground. This Gospel challenges everyone to examine what prevents them from bearing fruit and to remove those obstacles through prayer, repentance, trust in God, and faithful perseverance.

The parable also offers hope because God never stops sowing His Word. He patiently continues to invite all people into a deeper relationship with Him. The message encourages every Christian to become good soil by listening attentively, living faithfully, and producing the fruits of love, kindness, forgiveness, compassion, generosity, and service. In doing so, believers can reflect Christ's presence in the lives of others and bring glory to God through their daily witness.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a title of the Blessed Virgin Mary associated with Mount Carmel in the Holy Land. Hermits lived on Mount Carmel near the Fountain of Elijah (Northern Israel) in the 12th century. By the 13th century they had become known as "Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel". The title suggests that they saw Mary not only as a "mother" but also as a "sister". The word *sister* is a reminder that Mary is very close to us. She is a daughter of God and therefore can help us be authentic daughters and sons of God. Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the patroness of the Carmelite Order and is honoured for her protection, guidance, and motherly care.
