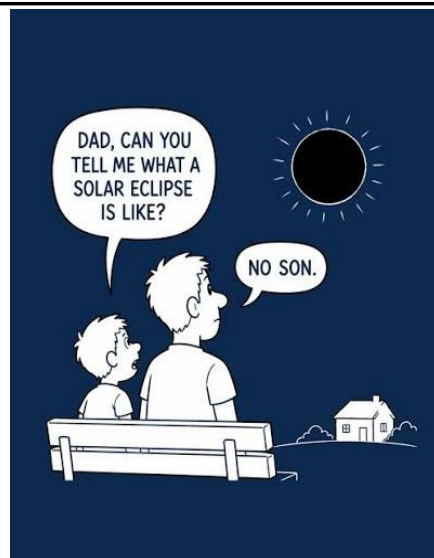


Donate old coins, notes or coins left over from foreign holidays.

A Faith That Never Gives Up

The Gospel story of the Canaanite woman is a reminder that genuine faith can be persistent, courageous and determined. She comes to Jesus carrying the suffering of her daughter, and although she encounters silence and rejection, she does not walk away. She continues to ask for mercy.



Her persistence reveals something important about prayer. Prayer is not always about receiving an immediate answer. It can mean remaining faithful when God seems silent, trusting that love has not disappeared. The woman's humility is matched by courage. She refuses to allow obstacles, or even the words spoken to her, to separate her from the hope she has placed in Jesus.

The Gospel also challenges the tendency to put limits on God's compassion. The woman stands outside the boundaries, yet her faith becomes an example for everyone. Jesus recognises and praises that faith, showing that God's mercy reaches beyond the barriers people create.

When faced with suffering, uncertainty or disappointment today, do not give up easily. Bring every need to God with honesty and perseverance. At the same time, be ready to recognise faith wherever it appears, especially in those who may seem different or distant. God's mercy is always greater than the boundaries we create.

ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL

St Mary's Cathedral will close temporarily from August 17 to allow essential conservation, accessibility and renewal works as part of the next phase in its development as the Cathedral of the Archdiocese of Dublin. During the closure period, major diocesan liturgies will take place in St Andrew's Church, Westland Row. The Palestrina Choir will be based at the College Chapel on the All Hallows Campus of DCU, by kind permission of the University. Parish and sacramental life will continue at St Joseph's Church, Berkeley Road, where the Cathedral Girls' Choir will also be based. Full details www.dublindiocese.ie/cathedral/.
