Essential Repair

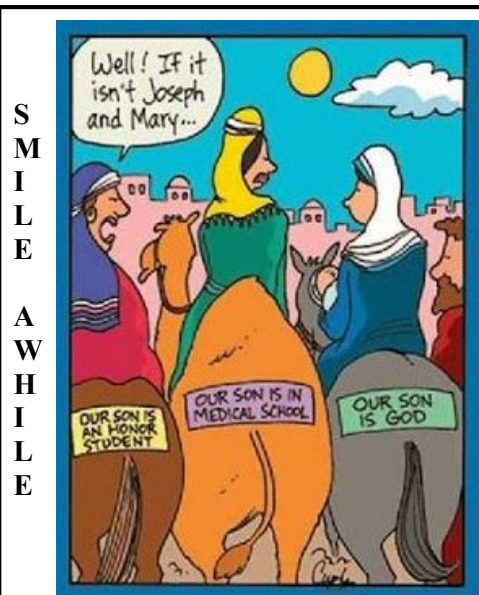
Repair work commenced this week on the right side retaining wall of the ramp in front of the church. As soon as the wall is complete a new hand rail will be installed for your safety and comfort.

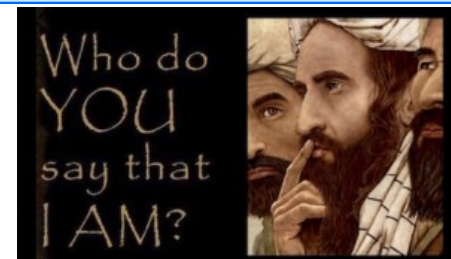

Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A, 23rd August 2026. Bulletin No: 1633.



The Gospel today invites a deeply personal question: Who is Jesus? It is easy to give an answer based on what others say, what has been learned, or what has been heard in church. But Jesus asks his disciples to go further: “Who do you say I am?”

Peter answers with courage and faith: Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. This is more than simply identifying who Jesus is; it is recognising that his presence can transform the whole direction of life.

Peter’s answer also reminds us that faith is not something that belongs only to theologians, priests or scholars. Every Christian is invited to discover, in a personal way, who Jesus is and what it means to follow him. Faith grows through prayer, through the Scriptures, through the support of the Christian community and through the ordinary experiences of daily life.

Jesus also entrusts Peter with responsibility for the community of believers. This reminds the Church that faith is never simply a private matter. Christians are called to build one another up, to offer encouragement and to become signs of Christ’s presence in the world.

The question Jesus asks Peter is still asked today: “Who do you say I am?” The answer is found not only in words, but in the way faith is lived each day.

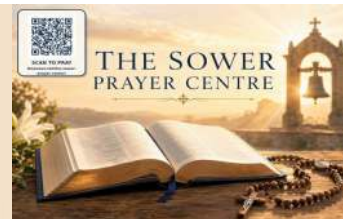
