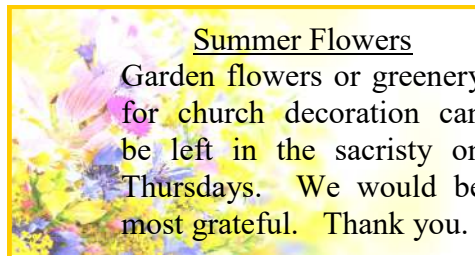


Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes
